

1. The Moment


Vehicles produce health-threatening air pollution

Unhealthy levels of air pollution can increase asthma attacks, heart attacks and strokes, lung cancer, and premature death.

Smog and soot air pollution caused by trucks and buses are among the greatest threats to public health for the more than 45 million people in the U.S. living within 300 feet of a major roadway or transportation facility.





Clean Transportation for All Campaign Priorities

- Adopting federal and state clean vehicle regulations
- Making active transportation safer and more accessible
- Reducing freight emissions in port, railyard, and warehouse areas
- Increasing funding for zero-emission transit and school buses
- Increasing access to EV charging infrastructure powered by renewable energy
- Increasing density by adding new housing, commercial, and retail to already developed neighborhoods









Smart Growth and Urban Infill



The Infill Task Force, made up of a team of Sierra Club staff and volunteers released the Infill Guidance for chapters and groups to use when engaging on land use issues.

A webinar series took a deeper dive into these main topics

- Land Use
- Housing Access for All
- Active Transportation and Transit
- Labor and Resilience

Since the release we have coordinated with chapters on comprehensive plans in counties and cities across the country, transit oriented development, and housing justice.

- Establish new transit to trails projects and routes





3. Advocacy

Maryland

A broad coalition is advocating for the Transportation and Climate Alignment (TCA) Act

TCA would require the Maryland Department of Transportation and regional transportation planning agencies to measure and mitigate any increases in climate pollution and VMT caused by planned highway expansion projects over \$10 million.

This will help expand transportation choices while reducing climate pollution.

3. Advocacy

Minnesota

Amtrak Borealis is a partnership with the Departments of Transportation in Illinois, Wisconsin, and Minnesota, with funding assistance from the Federal Railroad Administration.

More than 18,500 passengers rode the Borealis during its first month of service between Saint Paul and Chicago, generating around 150 new riders per trip outside the Chicago-Milwaukee corridor.

Its success has fueled energy for advocating for a third daily train in the corridor, and other passenger rail lines in Minnesota, such as the Northern Lights Express (NLX) between Minneapolis and Duluth, MN.



3. Advocacy

New York

Earlier this summer, Governor Hochul announced an "indefinite pause" of congestion pricing. Earthjustice, Sierra Club, Riders Alliance, and New York City-Environmental Justice Alliance filed a lawsuit on behalf of our collective members who need relief from the air pollution and traffic congestion, and the major MTA improvements such as elevators and faster subway services.

New York state leaders and our coalition reached an agreement to ensure that the Congestion Pricing Program will begin as scheduled on January 5, 2025.



NYS Department of Transportation Agrees to Begin Congestion Pricing

Congestion Pricing Program will begin Jan. 5, 2025, aimed at reducing traffic congestion and delivering cleaner air, faster subways, and funding for necessary transit upgrades.







