

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S LETTER



At the heart of our work is the belief that every person has the right to move through their community with dignity and safety, connecting with social, civic, and economic life. We stand alongside passionate individuals and organizations across the country, all dedicated to making this vision a reality.

2023 may have been our biggest year yet in terms of building a national movement.

We kept doing what we are known for - training, webinars, technical assistance, and advocacy. But 2023 additionally saw two unique events: the first national Week Without Driving and the first national convening of freeway fighters brought together hundreds of advocates around our shared vision of healthier and more equitable communities.

Collectively, our efforts and partnerships created safer streets, more walkable neighborhoods, and stronger community advocacy. Other efforts include our Intersections Initiative, which helped communities secure federal funding. Our Reconnecting Communities work successfully stopped certain federal funds from being misused for highway expansions (although there is much more to do here). We helped obtain new vehicle safety rules, intelligent speed assistance (ISA) pilots in municipal vehicles, and the repeal of outdated jaywalking laws.

Our Walking College fellows and grantees brought real, lasting change to their communities winning complete streets policies, building safer infrastructure, and even running for office. The Community Change Grant program funded projects to improve crosswalks, transit access, and public spaces, ensuring more people can move freely and safely.

We are deeply grateful for the ongoing support from communities nationwide. Movementbuilding is a long and difficult fight, but this year, we made real progress in undoing past injustices and shaping a healthier, more just future. We look ahead with hope, knowing that together, we will continue to create safer, more walkable communities for all.




